Umpire Convenor

Key Account-abilities:

- Report matters to the Club President
- Schedule and notify teams as to their umpiring duties
- Encourage and train any junior or senior who is willing to umpire and keep a record of all Umpires level of Certification
- Arrange Umpiring assistance to affiliated Clubs as requested where possible
- Provide a report at each Club meeting

Key Tasks:

- First point of contact for all umpires
- Communicate the 'learn to umpire' course details to all BWNC members when confirmed by WWPNA each year
- Mentor and support all umpires
- Promote any Netball NSW or WWPNA Umpire courses to all umpires
- Strive to prepare the umpire roster for each round e.g. a Five week period when draw is announced by WWPNA
- Contact to confirm with umpires as soon as possible if they are required to umpire during the round
- Have an emergency umpire list for backup when umpires are sick or unable to umpire on short notice – copy to Club Secretary at start of season
- Advise any BWNC Umpire if they are the 'Duty Umpire' and explain this role thoroughly
- Coordinate umpire payments at the end of each round (after five games).
